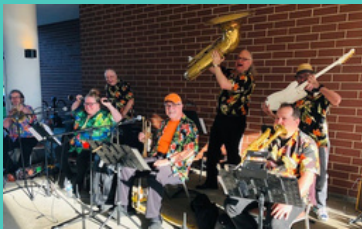
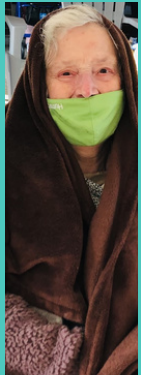
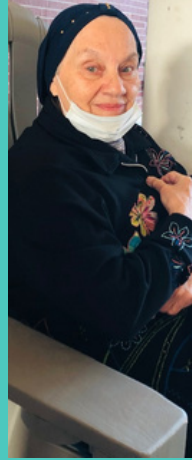
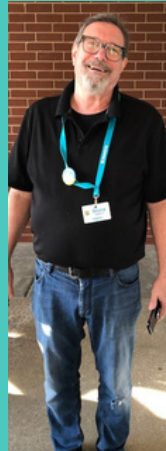
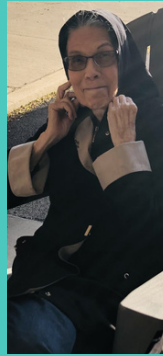
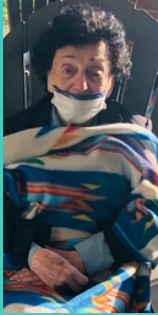
July is here and summer is in full swing, and The Fourth of July is right around the corner. We are blessed to live in a wonderful country full of goodness and opportunities
